TRAVEL

NO EVENT PARKING

There will be no parking provided on or around The Downs for attendees to the event.

Please note: there will be a number of road closures around the Downs and Sneyd Park on the day of the event. Almost all parking around the Downs and Sneyd Park will also be suspended. We urge you not to bring your private vehicle to this event and to use other travel options. If with a young family we recommend driving your vehicle to one of the Park and Ride locations and travelling by bus from there.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE/PARK & RIDE

"In partnership with First Bus we will be running an event shuttle bus service. The buses will run from Temple Meads (buses will depart from the short stay parking bays on the main station incline - bear left as you come out the station entrance) and The Centre (Stop on St Augustines Parade, opposite Boots heading to the event and dropping back to Baldwin Street on return). They will run to and from the event site from midday until midnight. Tickets can be bought on the bus – a single journey costs £3 and a return is £4 (a return shuttle bus ticket can also be used as a day rider ticket and used for any journey on the First Bus Inner Bristol Network). Child tickets are priced at £2 return / £1.50 single.

"First Bus will also be running park & ride services from Long Ashton (BS3 2HB) and The Portway sites (BS11 9QE). These services will run from 12.30 – midnight. Return Tickets will cost £4 (children travel for £2, but must be accompanied by an adult)."

CYCLING

To encourage cleaner travel around Bristol and provide facilities for cyclists to ride to this event, we are offering a bike park area for

people to leave their bikes in. Space will be allocated on a first come first serve bases, the area will have security all day but bikes are left at your own risk. Please make sure you bring a bike lock with you.

ACCESSIBILITY PARKING

After receiving a number of enquiries, we have reconsidered our position on allowing people who are not able to stand for long periods to bring chairs to the event. You will now be able to bring a chair or stool for your use throughout the day. Please be aware that this may increase the time taken to carry out searches at the main gate and that there may be some areas of site that it is not possible / appropriate to use the chair. When deciding whether to bring your own chair, please consider that we advise everyone attending the event to keep the personal belongings they bring with them to a minimum and that there will be some seating available around the site. We do however appreciate that bringing a chair will greatly improve the event experience for some people.
